Your programme consists of the following elements:

- ▶ Level 5 Diploma in Education and Training or equivalent
- ► Level 2 Safeguarding
- Competency Log portfolio of evidence covering the knowledge, skills and behaviours set out in the Apprenticeship Standard.
- Functional Skills Maths and English if required







Courses aims and objectives

The Learning and Skills Teacher (LST) Standard has been developed for those professionals having first achieved competence in a vocational or subject specialism and then subsequently trained as a teacher. The LST role is pivotal to the success of traineeship and apprenticeship programmes, in delivering effective vocational education and training that meets both learners' and employers' needs.

LSTs teach young people and adults within all parts of the ETS, including: work based/independent training provision; further, adult and higher education; offender-learning; and the voluntary sector. LSTs are responsible for planning and delivering learning that is current, relevant, challenging, and that inspires learners to engage and achieve their full potential. LSTs collaborate closely with colleagues and other ETS professionals in supporting learner progress. LSTs ensure the physical, psychological and social wellbeing of learners.

Functional Skills

If you have not acquired a full GCSE or equivalent level qualification to grade C/4 in English and Maths when you start your apprenticeship programme, you will be required to sit and pass the Functional Skills aspect of that subject during your scheme.



Competency Log

During your time on programme your Vocational Skills Coach will work with you to compile a portfolio of evidence built against the Standard Assessment Criteria and demonstrating the Knowledge, Behaviour and skills required.

The Learning and Skills Teacher will be expected to be able to demonstrate the following KSB's upon completion of the Standard:

- ▶ Plan learning effectively
- ▶ Design and deliver learning sessions and activities
- ► Facilitate individualised learning
- Quality assure outcomes for learners

Input sessions with your VSC take place monthly. Please note, all on-line sessions will be recorded.

End Point Assessment

During the last 2 months of your programme, we will put you in a Gateway to prepare you for End Point Assessment (EPA). This will be carried out by an independent EPA organisation. The formal assessment will comprise of:

- 2 Competence Observations / Discussion
- Professional Discussion underpinned by a portfolio of evidence
